INVESTMENT REPORT

Strategy

The Certificate aims to achieve optimal capital growth over the long term through the active management of a portfolio comprising mainly listed companies based in developed markets.

The investment strategy is based on a fundamental analysis: the stock selection process is based mainly on the activity of companies, their governance, financial structure, and development prospects. The Certificate aims, primarily, to identify companies with dominant positions, high reinvestment capacity, and low debt.

The recommended investment horizon is 5 years. The reference currency of the Certificate is the Euro, but the Certificate also invests in other currencies including the US Dollar, the Japanese Yen and the Swiss Franc.

Markets

European markets had another good month, with the Euro Stoxx 50 up +4.22%, the Stoxx Europe 600 up +3.65%, and the CAC 40 up +3.51%, and the same was true in the US, with the S&P 500 up +3.10%, the Nasdaq 100 up +1.17%, and the Dow Jones Industrials up +2.08%.

At the sector level, in the United States, that of oil and gas refining is up sharply at +17.92%, while the automobile manufacturers sector has lost -9.52%. In Europe, banks led the charge with +9.06%, while the technology sector gained only +0.63%.

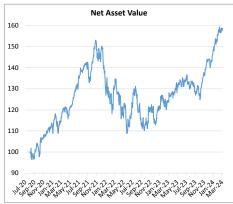
The Certificate

FFM Global Quality was up +1.27% during the month, whilst the MSCI World EUR was up +3.19%.

The monthly top three consisted of Walt Disney (+9.86%), Alphabet (+9.20%) and Novo Nordisk (+8.22%). On the other side, we find Palo Alto Networks (-8.34%), Sonova (-6.12%), and AMD (-6.08%).

During the month, we sold our position in UnitedHealth, having lost interest following a poorly managed cyberattack. We took the opportunity to increase positions in EssilorLuxottica and Palo Alto Networks, taking advantage of interesting entry points on these two stocks.

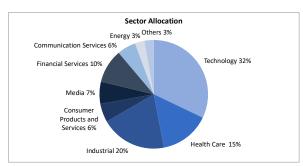
